

Packing up to 20W of power into a 2x1x0.4 inch package, with efficiency as high as 89%, the MKW3000 has wide input ranges of 9-18VDC, 18-36VDC and 36-75VDC and is available in output voltages of 3.3V, 5V, 12V, 15V, ±12V and ±15VDC.

Other feathers include continuous short circuit protection, overvoltage protection, remote on/off, six-sided shielded case, and EN55022 Class A conducted noise compliance minimize design-in time, cost and eliminate the need for external filtering.









## Block Diagram











Efficiency vs Input Voltage (Single Output)




Efficiency vs Output Load (Single Output)

Efficiency vs Input Voltage ( Dual Output )




Efficiency vs Output Load (Dual Output)

#### Test Configurations

#### Input Reflected-Ripple Current Test Setup

Input reflected-ripple current is measured with a inductor Lin (4.7uH) and Cin (220uF, ESR <  $1.0\Omega$  at 100 KHz) to simulate source impedance.


Capacitor Cin, offsets possible battery impedance . Current ripple is measured at the input terminals of the module, measurement bandwidth is 0–500 KHz.




#### Peak-to-Peak Output Noise Measurement Test

Use a Cout 1.0uF ceramic capacitor.

Scope measurement should be made by using a BNC socket, measurement bandwidth is 0-20 MHz. Position the load between 50 mm and 75 mm from the DC/DC Converter.





#### **Design & Feature Considerations**

#### Remote On/Off

Positive logic remote on/off turns the module on during a logic high voltage on the remote on/off pin, and off during a logic low.

To turn the power module on and off, the user must supply a switch to control the voltage between the on/off terminal and the –Vin terminal.

The switch can be an open collector or equivalent.

A logic low is -0V to 1.0V.

A logic high is 2.5V to 100V.

The maximum sink current at on/off terminal during a logic low is -100 uA.

The maximum allowable leakage current of the switch at on/off terminal (2.5 to 100V) is 5uA.

#### **Overcurrent Protection**

To provide protection in a fault (output overload) condition, the unit is equipped with internal current limiting circuitry and can endure current limiting for an unlimited duration. At the point of current–limit inception, the unit shifts from voltage control to current control. The unit operates normally once the output current is brought back into its specified range.

#### **Overvoltage Protection**

The output overvoltage clamp consists of control circuitry, which is independent of the primary regulation loop, that monitors the voltage on the output terminals.

The control loop of the clamp has a higher voltage set point than the primary loop.

This provides a redundant voltage control that reduces the risk of output overvoltage.



#### Input Source Impedance

The power module should be connected to a low ac–impedance input source. Highly inductive source impedances can affect the stability of the power module.

In applications where power is supplied over long lines and output loading is high, it may be necessary to use a capacitor at the input to ensure startup.


Capacitor mounted close to the power module helps ensure stability of the unit, it is recommended to use a good quality low Equivalent Series Resistance (ESR <  $1.0\Omega$  at 100 KHz) capacitor of a 22µF for the 12V input devices and a 6.8µF for the 24V and 48V devices.




#### **Output Ripple Reduction**

A good quality low ESR capacitor placed as close as practicable across the load will give the best ripple and noise performance.

To reduce output ripple, it is recommended to use 4.7uF capacitors at the output.





#### Maximum Capacitive Load

The MKW3000 series has limitation of maximum connected capacitance at the output.

The power module may be operated in current limiting mode during start-up, affecting the ramp-up and the startup time.


For optimum performance we recommend 270uF maximum capacitive load for dual outputs, 680uF capacitive load for 12V & 15V outputs and 6800uF capacitive load for 3.3V & 5V outputs.

The maximum capacitance can be found in the data sheet.

#### Thermal Considerations

Many conditions affect the thermal performance of the power module, such as orientation, airflow over the module and board spacing. To avoid exceeding the maximum temperature rating of the components inside the power module, the case temperature must be kept below 105°C.


The derating curves are determined from measurements obtained in an experimental apparatus.




